

New Deadline for ARC Agenda Items

After discussions with various community members about concerns regarding the last minute addition of items to the ARC Agenda, the ARC has decided to try a new system designed to avoid last minute additions to the ARC Agenda, except in unusual, time sensitive situations. In the future, the agenda for the ARC will close on Monday at noon, three days before the ARC meeting. The Agenda will be published, posted and available on the Genesee website no later than the next day, at noon. No new items will be added to the agenda for consideration except in unusual, time sensitive situations, and then only if immediate neighbors and others who have expressed an interest in the matter are otherwise notified.

The goal of this new system is to allow applicants as much time as possible to make filings before a meeting, but also to provide neighbors adequate notice of an application.

Filing dates which require a property posting will remain unchanged. Filings requiring posting must be filed by Friday, at noon, either thirteen days or six days before the next ARC meeting, depending on the length of the required posting period.
