Dear Genesee Resident,

The Foundation Board is grateful for the breadth of the community participation in our recent Security Patrol Survey. We received 509 surveys by our cutoff date, representing 58% of our community. That is a very high response rate and reflects the value you place on our security patrol.

Attached to this letter you will find a one page summary of all responses listed by question that we asked. If you wish to access the details behind the summary, you are encouraged to go to geneseefoundation.org, click on the "Board" button, then click on "survey details". In addition to the details you will also be able to access a complete list of the written comments which we received from residents by simply clicking on "survey comments". While it won't be possible to see who made the comments, it will be possible to read all of them. You may print a copy of the results and the comments from the website if you choose.

From the surveys your Board of Directors learned:

-8 out of 10 respondents believe that security is an important part of the community services as reflected in their scoring it 7 or greater on our 1-10 scale.

-8 out of 10 respondents want either 16 or 24 hour per day coverage and are willing to pay what it costs in order to get it.

-7 out of 10 respondents want that 16 or 24 hour per day coverage to be contracted through the JeffCo Sheriff's office as opposed to private security.

-only 1 respondent out of 16 wishes to have security eliminated.

Since security represents the largest single line item in our annual budget, we want to give you every opportunity to talk to us about it. To facilitate that, we have scheduled two open community discussion meetings at 7 PM on the nights of Tuesday, July 17 and Thursday, August 2. We are hopeful that if further thoughts or questions exist, you will take the opportunity to come to one of our open meetings and offer us your thoughts.

Thanks again for your response to our survey. Your participation will assist the Board in determining how to serve the community's needs.
